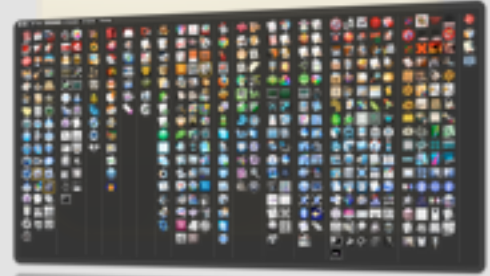


Welcome to Bevy™

The application launcher with a 50,000 foot view



Ask yourself if your Dock can do this...

- ✓ Create groups of icons from folders you specify. No adding icons one-by-one.
- ✓ Doesn't take up screen real estate. It's there when you need it and gone when you don't.
- ✓ Convenience. Use a global hot key, the menu bar, the Dock icon or even a cursor hot spot for quick and easy access.
- ✓ Highlight matching applications with a key press. Find what you need quickly.
- ✓ Drag-and-drop a file to highlight compatible applications. How cool is that?
- ✓ Hide icons you don't want to see. Rarely used apps and un-installers won't clutter your window.
- ✓ Always up-to-date. Uses Spotlight to keep track of changes so you don't have to.

How to Show and Hide Bevy



By default, the global hot key is “control-tab.”

Press the key combination once to show Bevy’s window.

Press it again to hide the window.

You can also click the Dock icon to show and hide the window.

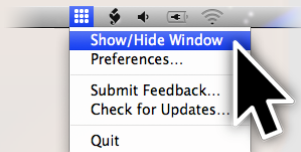
Click once to show the window. Click again to hide it.



You can also click Bevy’s icon in the menu bar to show and hide the window.

Click once to show the window. Click again to hide it. You can also drag an icon onto the menu bar icon to show Bevy's window for a subsequent drop.

Or, you can click-and-hold or control-click (right-click) on Bevy’s icon in the menu bar and choose “Show/Hide Window” (or from Bevy’s application menu).



And lastly, you can enable a cursor hot spot and simply move the cursor over the hot spot to show the window. Move the cursor away and back again to hide the window. This works great for drag-and-drop.

Highlight Names by Letter

Already know which application you need?

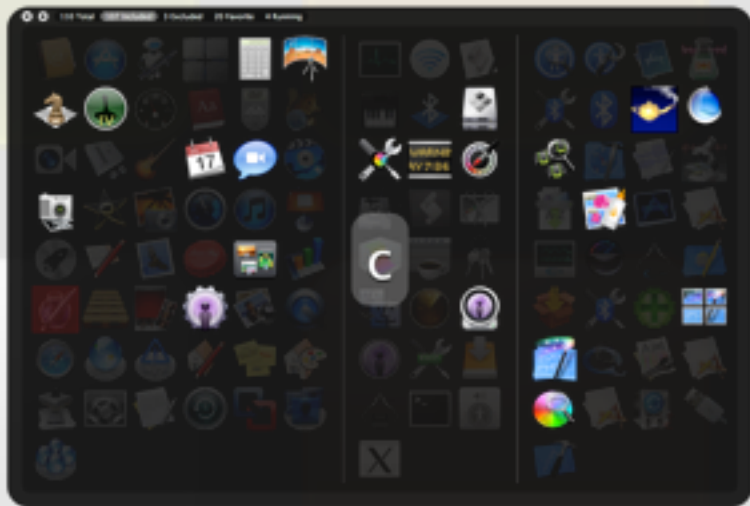
Just pop open Bevy's window and tap a letter or number key.

Bevy will highlight only those applications that have that letter or number in a significant spot in their name.

Type multiple letters and Bevy will match names that contain the string.

To see the name of an application, just point at its icon. Pause for a couple of seconds and you'll see its full path.

And Bevy highlights running application icons in a color of your choice.



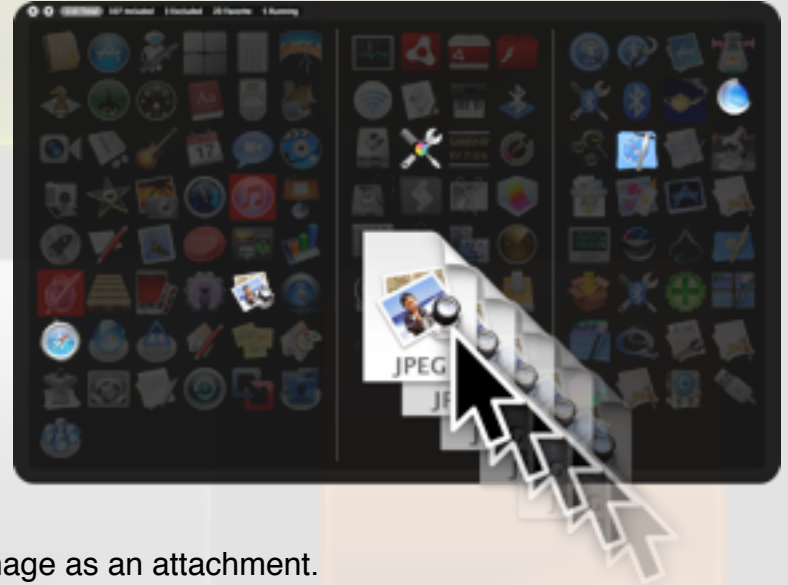
Drag & Drop

Need to edit an image but not sure which application you want to use?

Just move Bevy's window away from the center of the screen, then drag your image file to the window. Bevy will move the window back on-screen and highlight just the applications that can view or edit the image. How cool is that?

Press the command key and Bevy will highlight all the applications that can accept the image file, such as Mail which can't edit the image but can take the image as an attachment.

You can also drag to Bevy's menu bar icon to show the window for a subsequent drop.

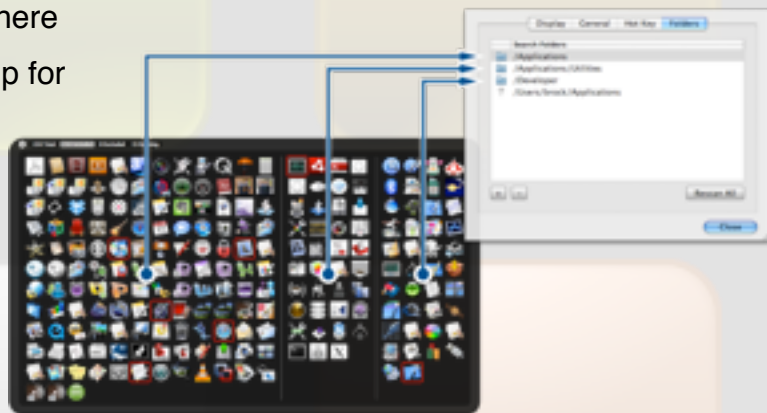


Rediscover Your Applications

By default, Bevy searches a standard set of folders where applications can be installed and creates an icon group for each folder it finds.

If you keep your applications elsewhere or you organize them into subfolders, then you'll love Bevy. You can add and remove folders and rearrange the list to control the order of their groups in the window. How you organize your apps in the Finder is how you'll see them in Bevy.

Plus, Bevy uses Spotlight to keep track of changes so you don't have to. When you make changes in the Finder, Bevy updates itself accordingly.



Customize Your View

You control the order and layout of the application icons.

Change window color, opacity and icon size to suit your style.

Display icons in columns, rows or even a single bunch if you prefer.

And you can sort icons within groups by subfolders or alphabetically, or even sort by color.

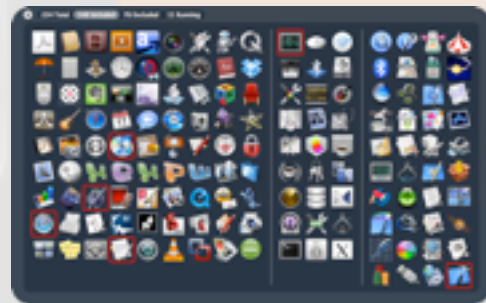


Hide Icons You Don't Need

Unlike other launchers where you add items one-by-one, in Bevy you start with a view of everything and hide or “exclude” items. Just hold down the shift key and click, and poof it's hidden.

Bevy keeps track of all your applications, remembering what should be excluded and what remains.

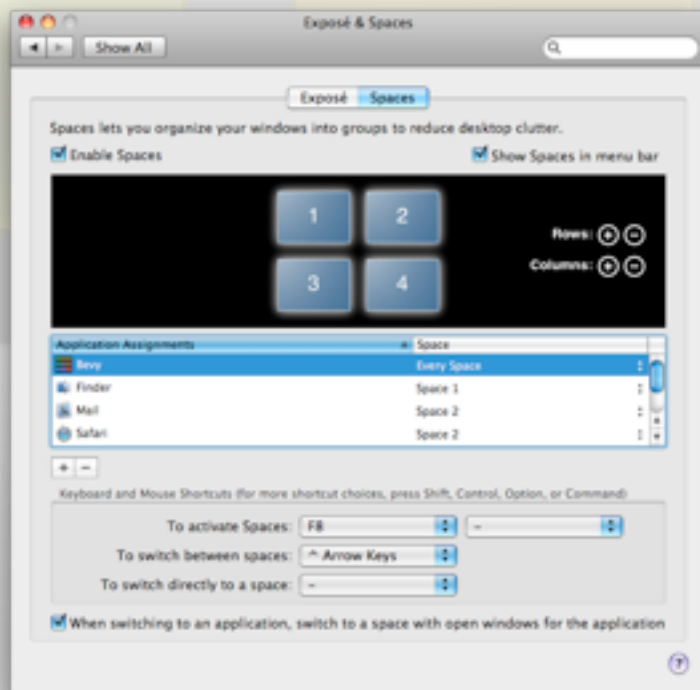
So at anytime, you can see any of your icons by using the buttons at the top of the window or shortcut keys. If you need something you previously excluded, just a quick click or key press puts it back in view.



If you're using Spaces (10.5-10.6) or Mission Control (10.7)...

Bevy is fully compatible with Spaces and Mission Control, but you need to assign Bevy to "Every Space" (10.5-10.6) or "All Desktops" (10.7) so that its window opens properly in whichever space/desktop you are currently in.

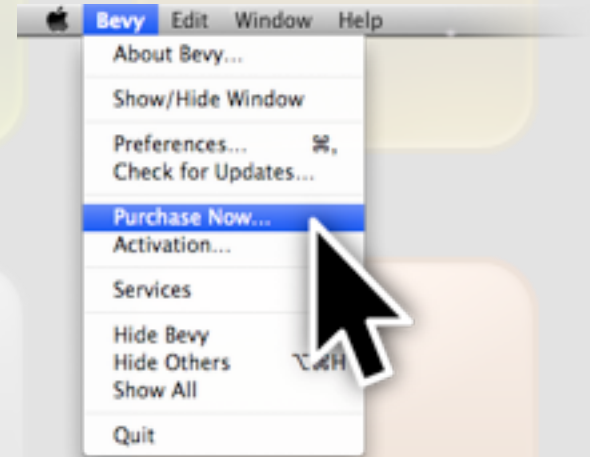


Easy to Purchase

Until Bevy is purchased and activated, it will run in trial mode.

This means that it is fully functioning, but the longer you use Bevy, the more mischievous and suggestive it becomes in reminding you to purchase.

When you're ready, Bevy is easy to purchase and activate using a secure, integrated web store. Just choose "Purchase Now..." from Bevy's application menu to complete your purchase through eSellerate, a long-time, trusted e-commerce provider for Mac software.
